Donomadé Model Farm

 197ha, 1.5cm/px GSD, 2 flights at 120m altitude with RXRII

 1763ha, 5,5cm/px GSD, 2 flights at 400m altitude with RX1RII

 209ha, 9cm/px GSD, 2 flights at 400m with MicaSense

Ministry of Environment and forestry areas

737ha of protected forest, 5cm/px GSD ,
 2 flights at 600m altitude with RX1RII

 Aveve town, protected forest and river border with Benin 3900ha, 17cm/px GSD, 5 flights at 600m altitude with QX1 15mm



Challenges to face

- Weather conditions: +35 degrees Celsius, harmattan (dust and sand wind from Sahara)
- Battery charger blew up and smoked when first battery charge attempt. Finally use only the car battery cables.
- 3h walk in the forest to fly Togodo forest, when arrived : low battery radio and redEdge topcover missing + some buffalo trap on the way
- Fire in the bushes
- Wingtraone on a motorcycle
- + EKF interference before takeoff, even in the savanna
- + BVLOS flights = RC and Telemetry loss = lot of stress
- + Take-off from tight area and even a house's terrasse

Final use of the data, Quoted from Lucas Baumann:


- Snap-Shot of the current state of the farm and the region to compare to a retake in 2-5 years and visualize/measure the impact of the project

The results are of great value to the entire project. The association Happy Togo is very thankful for this fruitful partnership with Wingtra.



Final use, quoted from Gilles K. ETSE, Biologist & Environmentalist Specialized in Remote Sensing and GIS for Ministry of Environment and Forestry:

"The orthophotos acquired during the flights will be used for the development of a management plan of the flood zone in Mitragyna in the canton of Aklakou (3000 ha) in the context of the implementation of priority options for the restoration of forest landscapes in the prefecture of the Lakes"

"For this purpose, a land use map will be produced and management maps will also be produced from the data acquired."

Togodo Forest Data will be used to identify trees composition in order to install a small model forest on the model farm
